I. Call to Order

Chairman Roche called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with greetings and introductions of all participants while Nancy Donovan Farina recorded the minutes.

II. Approval of the Minutes

Chairman Roche called for discussion the minutes of the June 21, 2013 NAC meeting. Upon agreement of no other revisions to the minutes, [REDACTED] motioned for approval. [REDACTED] made a motion and [REDACTED] seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

III. Noise Complaints

Chairman Roche called on Bonnie Teeuwen, Acting Airport Manager to report on the final 2nd and 3rd quarter 2013.

The 2nd quarter had 7,951 operations from April 1, 2013 to June 2013. Reports indicate that 11 complaints were received and 3 public records/general comments requests. 6 complaints occurred between the hours of 0700L and 2300L and reports indicate that all 5 were local. 5 noise complaints were

received between the hours of 2300L and 0700L. Sixty- nine VNA (Voluntary Noise Abatement) hour operations were logged.

The 3rd quarter had 6,736 operations from July 1, 2013 to September 2013. Reports indicate that a total of 25 noise complaints and 0 public records requests were received. 12 noise complaints occurred between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., 11 were local and one itinerant. 10 noise complaints occurred between the hours of 0700L and 2300L. Forty-three VNA hour operations were logged.

The number of operations reported above is provided by Scott Huth, Air Traffic Control Manager which is the actual take-offs, landings and missed approaches.

All noise complaints reflected in highlighted areas on the noise complaint spread sheet; reflect calls received from individuals that had occurred in the voluntary noise abatement hours, and confirmed as operations that occurred at the Airport. Their address has been reflected on the neighborhood noise map.


Revised NAC Meeting dates and times

V. Public Comment A constituent from Richmond Heights that wished to be unidentified; suggested meeting dates be in the evenings and posted in other areas besides the newspaper.


VI. Adjournment
